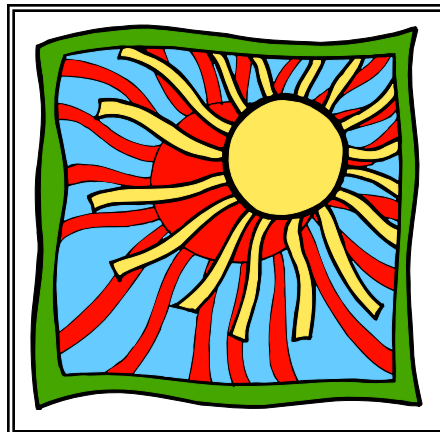

On Saturday, Sept. 11, at 7pm, Walnut Grove Lutheran Church will host Great Is Thy Faithfulness: A Benefit Concert for Pakistan. The event will feature singer-songwriter Grete Norquist, with guest musicians from Trinity Western University and area churches. Flooding of Pakistan’s Indus River began over a month ago and has affected an estimated 20 million people. In addition to destroying crops, roads, and homes, the floods carry the threat of fast-spreading, water-borne disease. Proceeds from the concert will go to World Vision, and all donations will be matched by the government’s Pakistan Floods Relief Fund.

Dear Zion,

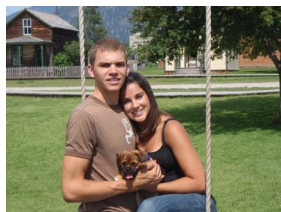
We send greetings from Sicily! We have been here for a month now and have already learned so many new things from God. We were surprised to see how Sicily is a very oppressed place -for the Christians here and the local people trying to work and make a living in the poor economy. We went to a church that had just been built for the 3rd time as the mafia kept burning it down.

Our boat, the Next Wave, draws lots of attention in the ports, for its looks and for mission it holds. A press conference was held on the boat by Greek and Italian government officials, where pictures and videos of the conference (and the boat and its purpose) made it onto a few news channels and newspapers. This was very exciting because it is the first time in Italian media history where Christians were portrayed in a positive way!
